



Yard Waste Program Options – City of Hudson

Yard waste cannot be placed in the trash. Advanced Disposal Services offers two options to City of Hudson residents for yard waste services. All yard waste must be placed at the curb/street side. Yard waste will not be picked up in the alleys.

Option 1: Subscription Yard Waste Program. This program will run from April 1 through November 30 weather permitting. Residents will be provided with use of a 95 gallon cart that will be clearly marked with a yard waste sticker.

Customers who subscribe to the program will be automatically scheduled for every week pick up and will not have to call in or purchase the tags or bio-degradable bags for the material that fits in the cart. Additional bags must be placed next to cart in bio-degradable bags.

Advanced Disposal Services will remove up to 10 extra bio-degradable yard waste bags or small bundles of brush each week at no additional charge. Brush needs to be bundled, no longer than 3 feet in length, and weigh less than 40 pounds.

The cost for the residents will be \$90.00 for the year or \$20.00 per month. These residents will be billed separately for this service by Advanced Disposal Services.

Option 2: Yard waste by the Bag or Brush by the Bundle. Curbside collection stickers can be purchased at EconoFoods, County Market or City Hall. Stickers need to be placed on a bio-degradable yard waste bag one per bag. Brush needs to be bundled, no longer than 3 feet in length, and weigh less than 40 pounds. The sticker should be adhered to each bundle. Bags and bundles need to be placed at the curb, and you must contact Advanced Disposal Services at 866-983-6542 by noon on Thursday for a Friday pick-up.
