

Grandview Drive Street Improvements Project Weekly Project Update August 11, 2017

The City of Hudson is currently reconstructing Grandview Drive from Vine Street to Laurel Avenue. The duration of the project is June 21, 2017 to the substantial completion date of August 18, 2017. Construction includes removals, minor storm sewer, complete curb replacement, pedestrian ramps, bituminous surfacing and restoration.

Work Completed for the Week of August 7th

Monarch Paving finished backfilling and spreading topsoil behind the curb. Monarch also started shaping the topsoil to prepare for seeding operations next week.

Work Scheduled for the Week of August 14th

On Monday and Tuesday, Monarch will finish shaping the topsoil and start seeding the boulevards. Monarch also is planning on removing all of the old signs along Grandview and installing the new signs on Tuesday.

Weather permitting, Monarch Paving is planning to pave Grandview Drive and intersections on Wednesday, August 16th. Lane restrictions will be in place during the paving process.

Residents should also be aware that entrances to cul-de-sacs, private driveways, common driveways and intersections will be closed for brief periods of time as the crew completes the paving of these areas where they connect to Grandview Drive.

After paving, Monarch will stripe the roadway.

Traffic Impacts

Grandview Drive is anticipated to be closed off to all through traffic starting June 21st and last throughout the duration of the project. All access to homes on or directly off of Grandview Drive will need to be through Hunter Hill Road. The detour plan will also be posted for more detailed directions regarding access.

Parking

For public safety and project efficiency, no parking will be allowed on Grandview Drive. Residents may park in their driveways and on side streets for a majority of the project.
