

## Hanley Road Street Improvements Project Weekly Project Update

**June 15, 2018**

**The City of Hudson is currently reconstructing Hanley Road from Carmichael Road to State Highway 35. The duration of the project is May 2, 2018 to the substantial completion date of July 27, 2018. Construction includes removals, minor storm sewer, curb replacement, pedestrian ramps, bituminous surfacing, turn lane additions and restoration.**

### **Work Completed for the Week of June 11**

Monarch Paving finished the curb and gutter on the outside lanes, driveway aprons for Red Cedar Canyon and Milestone Quarry, and valley gutters at East Canyon Drive and Rock Street. Street light conduits were also installed and bases were poured for two light poles behind the new right turn lanes. Late in the week, Monarch graded the turn lanes and are paving them on Friday.

### **Work Scheduled for the Week of June 18**

Monarch Paving is planning to remove pavement, grade and pave East Canyon Drive next week along with grading and paving the trail along the right turn lane to O'Neil Road south. Monarch Paving will also finish the pedestrian ramps and backfill curb.

### **Traffic Impacts**

***Rock Street access to Hanley will be closed off until Friday evening, June 15<sup>th</sup>. East Canyon Drive will be closed into next week, with the goal of opening back up for the weekend.***

Hanley Road is anticipated to be narrowed to one lane each direction throughout the duration of the project. The outside lanes will be blocked off for most of the project but there are times that traffic will be shifted to the outside lanes when working on the medians. All access to homes and businesses off of Hanley Road will still be available. Some intersections may need to be closed for periods of time but one access north and one access south will be available at all times. Delays are expected through Hanley Road during the project so other routes (Stageline Road) may be a better route for some residents.
